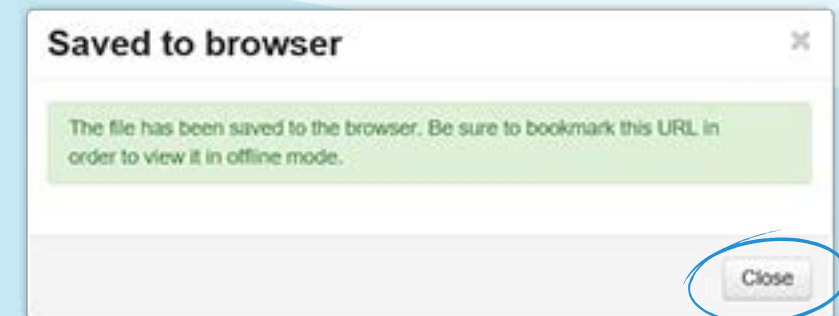
# INTERNET EXPLORER

Begin with opening the publication from the “My Publications” page.



## STEP 1

Now select the  “Save to browser” button in the top right corner

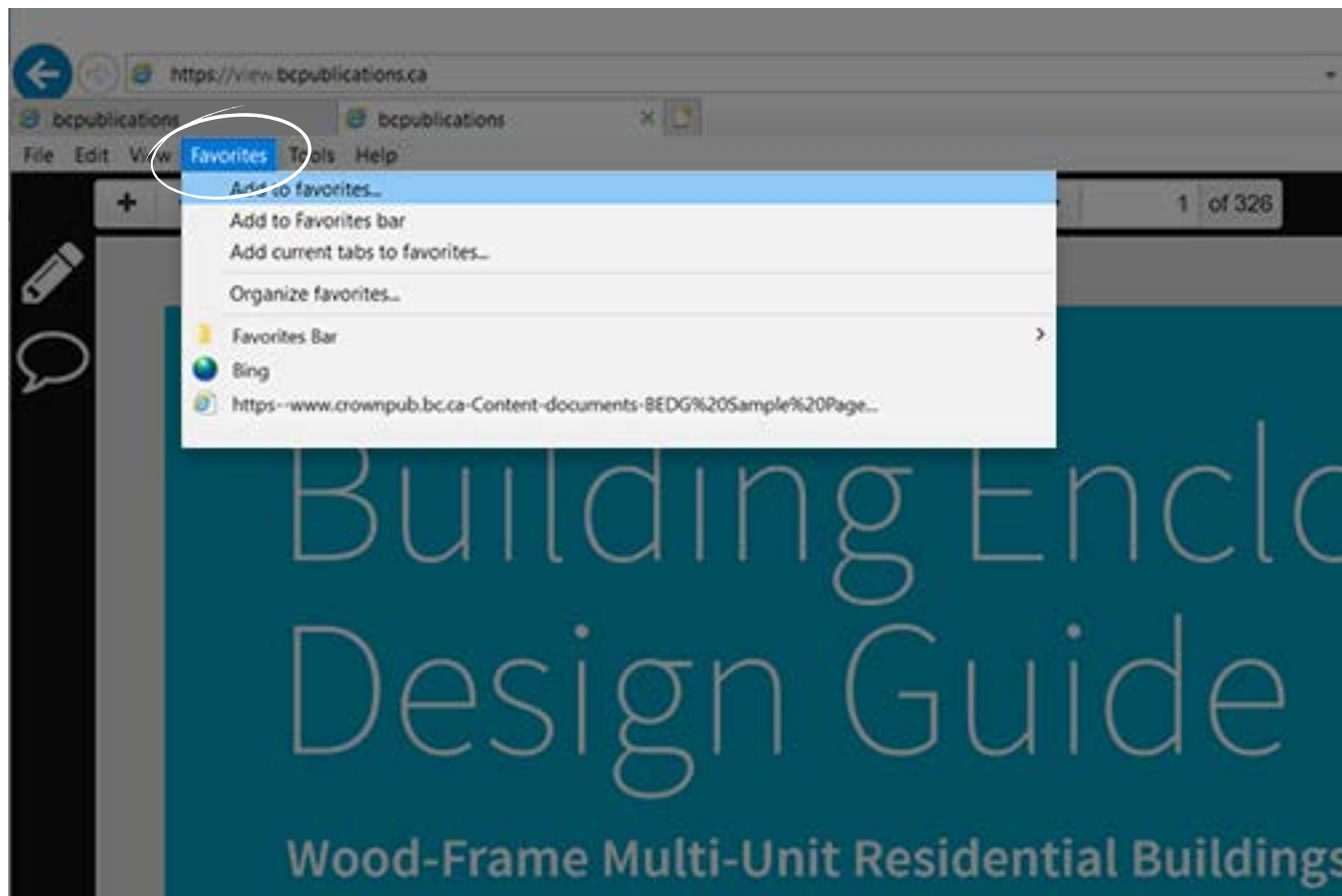


Once completed the following message will appear. Select the “Close” button

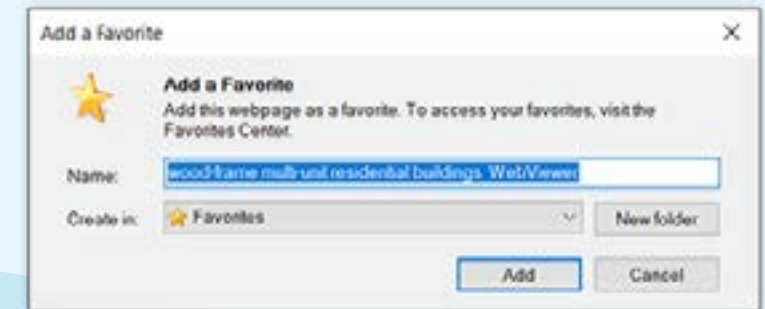

## ★ STEP 2: ADD TO FAVORITES


Bookmark the URL by selecting the “Add to Favorites” option. From the top Menu select the “Favorites”, then from the drop down select the “Add to Favorites” option or select the ☆ Favorites icon.



The “Add to Favorite” dialogue box will appear and users may change the favorite name within the Name field at this time. Next select the “Add” button.



The “Add to Favorite” dialogue

 Anytime the workstation is offline (not connected to the internet) this link within the Favorites will provide the user access to the bookmarked offline copy. To access this link launch Internet Explorer, Open list of Favorites and select the title as originally saved.

Begin with opening the publication from the “My Publications” page

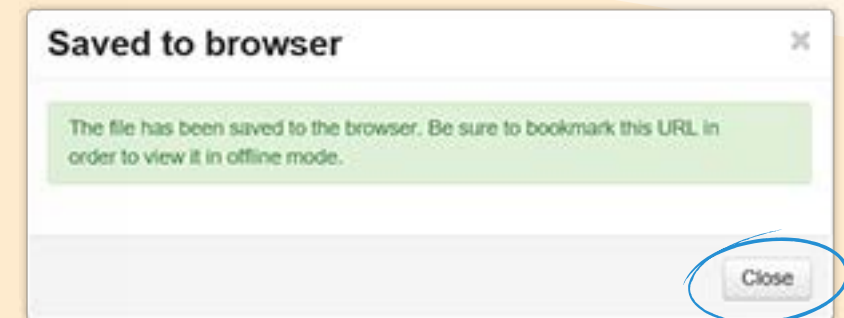


## STEP 1

The browser will begin saving and the following box will appear.

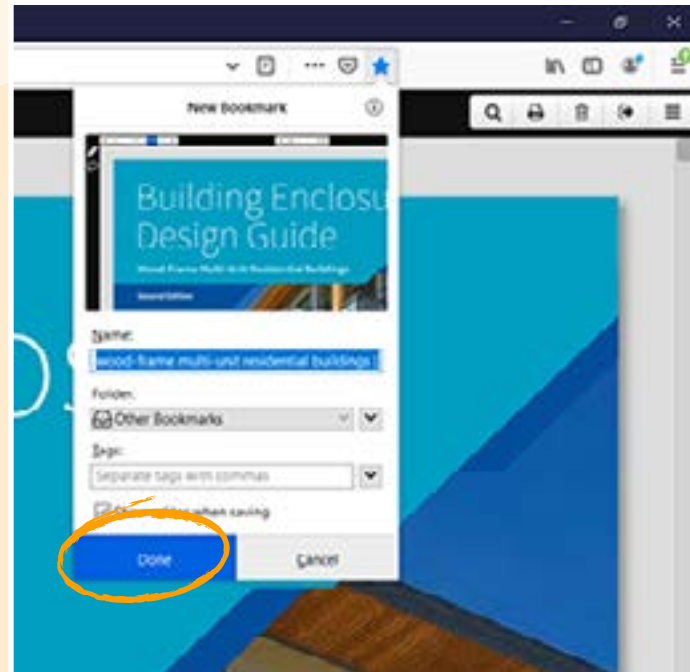


Once completed the following message will appear. Select the “Close” button

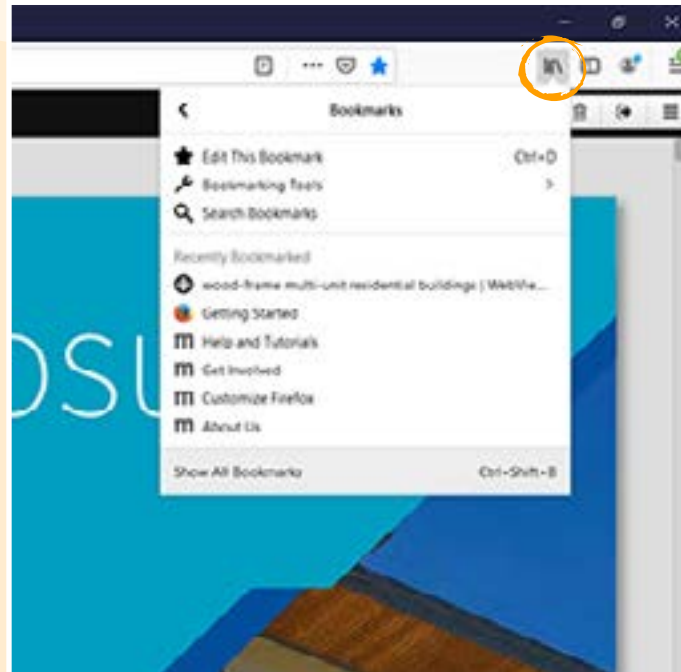

Next the “**New Bookmark**” dialogue box will appear. Users may select the name of the bookmark as well as the folder location. Complete and select the “**Done**” button.



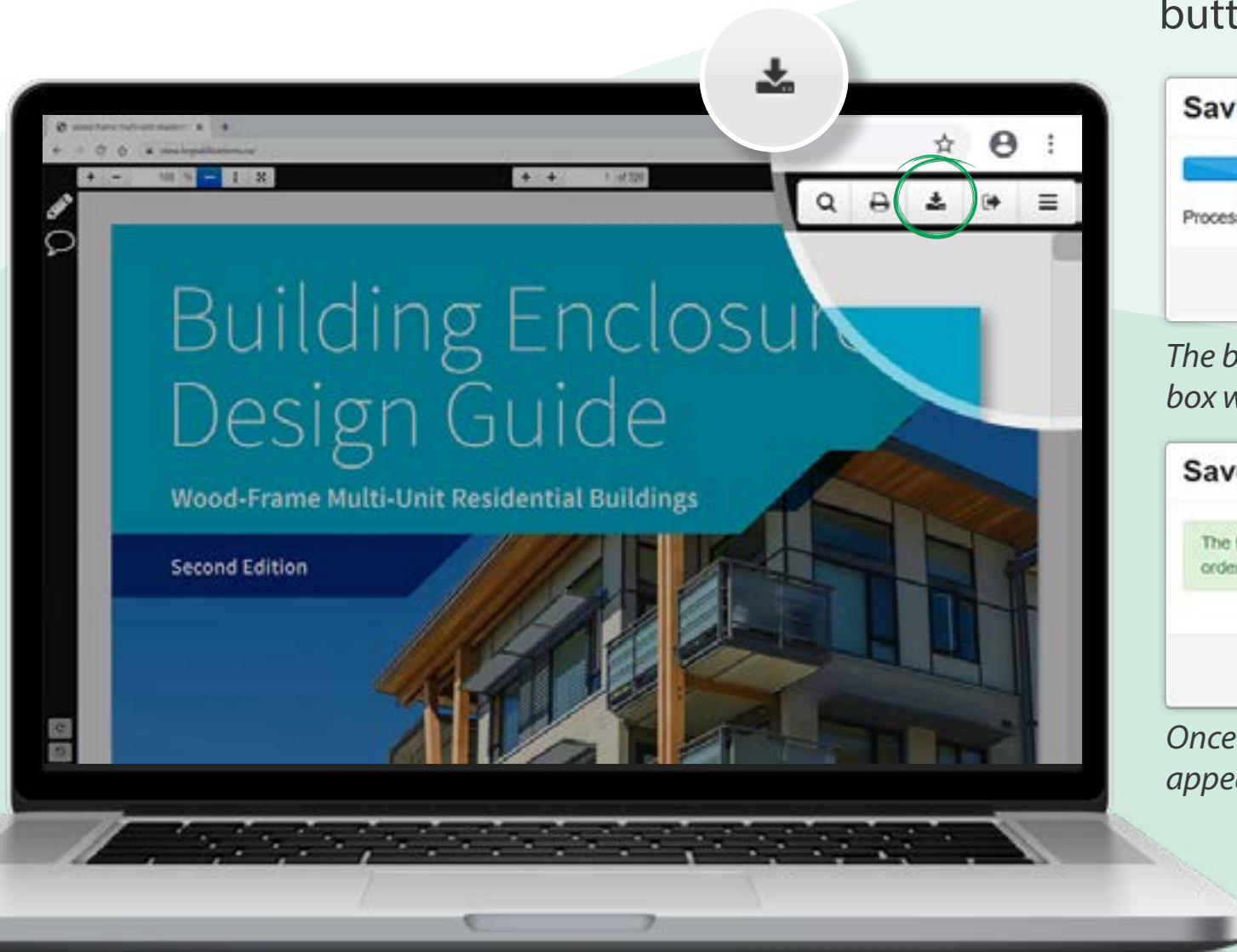
The bookmark will now appear within the user's library

# ★ FAVORITES BAR

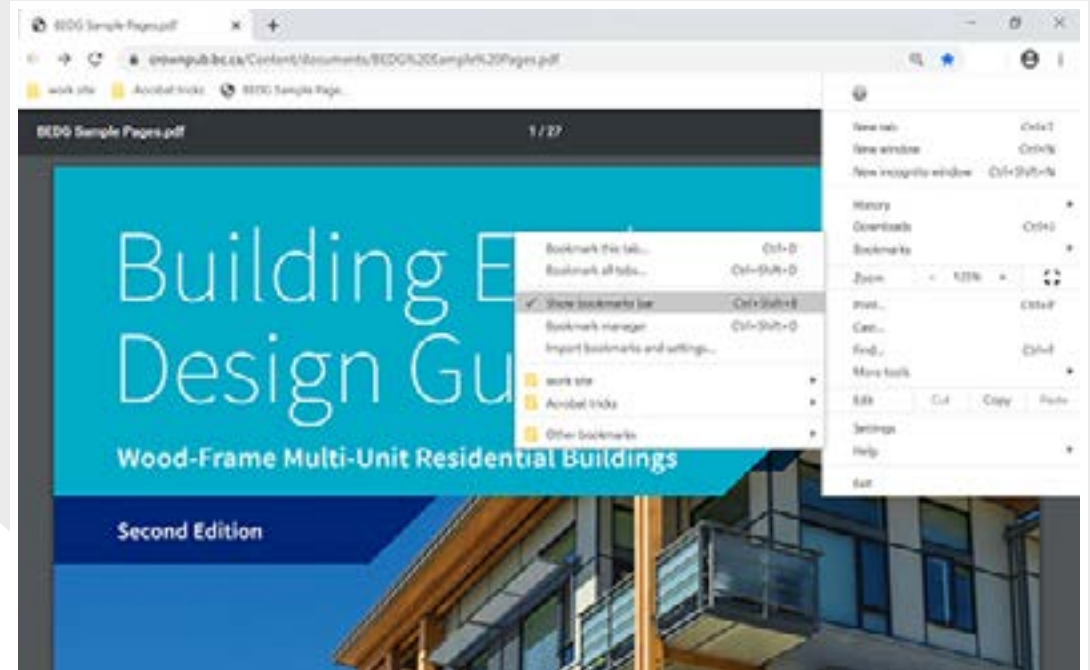
## How to Display the Tool Menu

“Favorites” or “Bookmarks” (in Firefox) are links to web pages that make it easy to get back to your favorite places. This section help you display the tool bar in different browsers.



## INTERNET EXPLORER

1. In the upper-right corner of the browser window right-click the ☆ star icon;
2. Select ✓ Menu Bar.



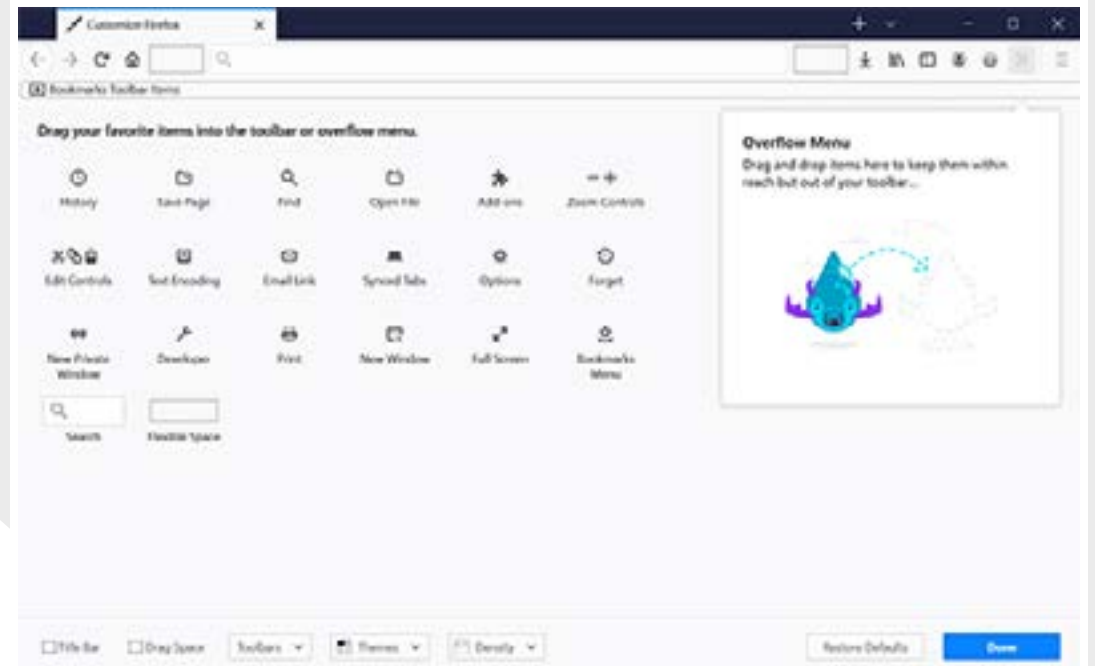
## GOOGLE CHROME

1. In the upper-right corner of the browser window click the ⚙️ Customize and Control Google Chrome icon;
2. Select ✓ Show bookmarks bar

How to show the “favorites bar”.



## FIREFOX

To enable the Bookmarks Toolbar:

1. Click the menu button  **Menu** and choose  **Customize**.
2. Select  from the dropdown menu at the bottom of the screen.

3. Select  **Bookmarks Toolbar**.
4. Click the  button when you're finished.
